

We are very proud of Cherry class for demonstrating this Opal Power in the community and they have been awarded some Opals for their class gem jar.






Year 5 and 6 have been enjoying the book "The Secret Garden" this week and the staff have been so impressed with the quality of writing the children have been producing.

This term their enquiry question is **'How do scientists classify materials**'. They have sorted materials based on their properties and discussed how properties of materials are used when designing products. They are now designing and making our own thermos flask based on their understanding of thermal conductivity. (Watch this space for final outcomes!) We will then be looking at electrical conductivity.






Gem stars this fortnight:








Holly class dug for pebbles as part of their English immersion for the new text, 'The Pebble in my Pocket'. This has inspired the children to write, and to include features such as personification, similes and prepositions.

In Enquiry, they've been learning about volcanoes and earthquakes. One of our focus questions has been: *Why do people live near volcanoes? Would you choose to live near one?* They also brought tectonic plates to life with a hands-on activity using an orange! They peeled it, split the peel into 'plates,' and reassembled them to understand how tectonic plates fit together and move. Great work Holly class!
